

**HAMLET OF REPULSE BAY
BY-LAW NUMBER 104**

A by-law to regulate the disposal of garbage at the municipal dump, pursuant to the Hamlet Act, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c. H-1, s.86.

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Repulse Bay in the Northwest Territories deems it expedient to regulate the dumping of garbage within municipal boundaries other than Hamlet employees,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Hamlet of Repulse Bay, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

- 1 This By-law may be cited as "Regulation of Municipal Dump By-law."

INTERPRETATIONS

2. In this by-law,

| "Council" | means the Council of the Hamlet; |
| "Hamlet" | means the Hamlet of Repulse Bay; |
| "users" | means a government user, commercial user or non-commercial user; |
| "permit" | means a permit issued by the Hamlet as per attached Schedule A; |
| "garbage" | means garbage, refuse or other waste; |
| "garbage service" | means pickup and disposal of garbage; |
| "commercial user" | means a commercial or industrial firm, organization, company, partnership, or sole proprietorship, whether incorporated or unincorporated which uses garbage services; |
| "government user" | means Government of Canada, the Government of the Northwest Territories, Crown Corporations, the Northwest Territories Housing Corporation, the Hamlet or any agency of any of them which uses garbage services; |

- "excess garbage" means any garbage not stowed in the barrels or other containers provided;
- "schedule" means a schedule attached to and forming part of this by-law.

REGULATIONS

3. Subject to the provisions of this by-law:
- (i) No person, commercial users or government user shall use the municipal dump unless authorized to do so by a permit issued by the Hamlet.
 - (ii) Any person, commercial or government user disposing of garbage at the municipal dump must do so in accordance with the restricted areas as detailed in this by-law.
 - (iii) The restricted areas shall be designated as follows:
 - (a) sewage disposal pit;
 - (b) honeybag storage site;
 - (c) old wreck disposal site;
 - (d) combustible waste site;
 - (e) waste oil site;
 - (f) any other disposal site as authorized and approved by Council.
 - (iiii) No person, commercial or government user shall burn garbage unless authorized to do so by the Hamlet.
 - (iiiii) The hours of operation for the dump shall be as authorized and approved by the Council.

PAYMENT

4. Per attached schedule B and C.
- (I) Cost of permits per attached Schedule B.
 - (ii) Penalty for noncompliance with this by-law per attached Schedule C.

REVIEW

5. This by-law shall be reviewed each fiscal year.

DATE OF EFFECT

6. This by-law shall come to effect upon receiving third reading

READ a Second Time this 27th day of August, 1992 A.D.

Any person who uses the municipal dump without first obtaining a permit is guilty of an offense and is liable to a fine not exceeding \$100.00(one hundred dollars) for each day that this by-law is not adhered to.
