



By-law # 4

By-law pertaining to the use of

snowmobiles:

1. All person driving snowmobiles shall drive on the right side of the road. At the cross sections of the road every driver shall stop to see if there are other snowmobiles before proceeding.
2. No snowmobiles shall be parked on the road used by vehicles. If a snowmobile is damaged as a result of being parked on the road the Council shall not be held liable.
3. All snowmobiles shall have driving lights on at night both front and back within the settlement and shall be equipped with brakes.
4. There shall be no speeding at any time within the settlement.
5. No snowmobile shall drive within 50 feet behind a moving vehicle.
6. Nobody shall drive a snowmobile after the hours of 12:00 midnight except for emergencies and before 5:00 a.m.
7. There shall be no snowmobile riding at the school playground at any time.
8. In the winter if a snowmobile or other things is buried under the snow used by the road maintenance drivers, the owner shall notify the driver immediately. If as a result of the owner failing to warn the driver the snowmobile is damaged by the road maintenance driver, the Council shall not be held liable.

If the above by-law is broken by an individual once that person shall be given a warning. If the same individual breaks it the second time he or she shall be given another and stronger warning. If the same individual breaks the by-law the third time his or her snowmobile shall be seized and he or she shall be fined.

Read a first time this 4th day of January, 1979.

Read a second time this 18th day of January, 1979.

Read a third time this 18th day of January, 1979 and passed by resolution
