



HAMLET OF REPULSE BAY

BY-LAW NO. 4A

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE HAMLET OF REPULSE BAY IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO REGULATE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS *Section 169 of the Municipal Ordinance, being Chapter M-15 of the revised Ordinance of the Northwest Territories, 1974, as amended, provides for the regulation of highway traffic within the municipality;*

AND WHEREAS *The SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE, being Chapter S-7 of the Revised Ordinance of the Northwest Territories, 1974 as amended, provides for the enactment of municipal BY-LAWS for the control, use and operation of snowmobiles on highways and other areas within the municipality;*

NOW THEREFORE *The COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF REPULSE BAY in a meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:*

1. SHORT TITLE

This by-law may be cited as the Highway Traffic By-law.

2. INTERRETATION

In this By-law:

- a) *"Municipality" means the HAMLET of REPULSE BAY as established and continued under the Municipal Ordinance.*
- b) *"Officer" means a By-Law Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer, or other officers designated by the COUNCIL OF REPULSE BAY.*
- c) *"Motor Vehicle" means every vehicle powered by a combustion engine other than aircraft, snowmobile, and motorcycles.*
- d) *"Motorcycle" means every two or three wheeled vehicle powered by a combustion engine.*
- e) *"Snowmobile" means a motorized vehicle weighing less than 1500 pounds that is designed or intended to be used on snow or ice or both.*

3. EQUIPMENT

- a) *No person shall operate or permit the operation on a roadway of a vehicle that is in such a dangerous or unsafe operating condition as to endanger the driver or any occupant thereof, or any person on the roadway.*
- b) *A motor vehicle must be equipped as outlined in the Vehicle Ordinance Chapter V-2 of the Revised Ordinance of the Northwest Territories, 1974, as amended.*
- c) *A snowmobile or motorcycle must be equipped as follows:*
 - i) *with a headlight which is in good working order.*
 - ii) *With a tail light that shows a red light visible at a distance.*
 - iii) *With a braking system which shall be maintained in good working order at all times; and*
 - iv) *With a muffler that prevents unreasonable noise in the operation of the engine.*

4. OPERATION

- a) *The owner or operators of a motor vehicle shall be subject to the provisions of the Vehicle Ordinance, being Chapter V-2 of the Revised Ordinance of the Northwest Territories, 1978, as amended.*
- b) *The driver or operator of motor vehicle shall not drive it on the roadways at a speed greater than twenty (20) kilometers per hour.*
- c) *The driver or operator of a snowmobile or motorcycle:*
 - i) *shall not drive or operate it on the roadways, or within the HAMLET property, at a speed greater than twenty (20) kilometers per hour.*
 - ii) *shall not drive or operate it abreast of any other person who is driving or operating a motor vehicle, snowmobile or motorcycle:*
 - iii) *shall not use it while under the influence of alcohol or other drugs; and*
 - iv) *shall not park or leave it either unattended or attended on a roadway so as to obstruct the free passage of traffic.*
 - v) *no person under the age of 14 years shall drive or operate a snowmobile or motorcycle on roadways, or within the Hamlet proper.*
 - vi) *the driver or operator of a snowmobile or motorcycle shall drive as near as practical to the right hand curb or edge of a roadway.*
 - vii) *no person shall drive or operate a snowmobile upon a highway if there is a usable path intended for the use of snowmobiles adjacent to roadway.*
 - viii) *Every person who rides on a two wheel motorcycle shall wear a helmet.*

4. OPERATION cont'd

d) No snowmobiles/motorbikes will be operated within the Municipality between the hours of 12 o'clock midnight and 5 o'clock a.m. except hunters going to and from hunting around and any emergency happening during curfew hours.

5. PENALTIES

a) Every person who contravenes a provision of this BY-LAW is guilty of an offence and is liable upon summary convictions:

- i) for the first offence to a fine not exceeding five (5.00) dollars.*
- ii) For the second offence to a fine not exceeding ten (10.00) dollars.*
- iii) For the third and subsequent offences to a minimum fine of fifteen (15.00) dollars, to a maximum fine of fifty (50.00) dollars.*

6. ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS

Owners of a snowmobile or motorcycle shall incur the penalties provided for any contravention of this BY-LAW, unless at the time of contravention, The motor vehicle, snowmobile, or motorcycle was in possession of another person without the owner's consent, in which case the owner shall not be liable and other person shall incur the penalties provided.

7. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Save as herein otherwise provided, the provisions of the Ordinance respecting Snowmobiles and Highway Traffic, being Chapters S-8 and V-2 of the Revised Ordinance of the Northwest Territories, 1974, as amended, apply mutates mutants to the control of snowmobiles, motor vehicles, motorcycles or pedal bicycles with motor attachments.

8. TRAFFIC CONTROL

- a) Council may be resolution, from time to time, have traffic signs placed at specified locations within the municipality.*
- b) Traffic signs erected in locations approved by Council shall be set out in a schedule to be attached hereto and to form a part of this BY-LAW, including the type of sign (STOP-YIELD-SCHOOL ZONE, etc.) and the location.*
- c) Traffic signs shall be a design that meets the national standard.*

9. REPEAL

This BY-LAW shall repeal Commissioners order to regulate snowmobiles in the settlement of REPULSE BAY in the NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, and shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof and shall remain in effect until repealed or amended.

READ a first time this 24th day of MAY 1984.

READ a second time this 28th day of JUNE 1984.
